During the project's lifecycle, we have developed numerous learning resources. Through the **Media Hacks e-learning platform** (MOOC), anyone interested in using these materials can access them for free and without any restrictions. The Media Hacks resources include...

- ✓ A **community audit toolkit** conducted in a local community of each partner country, which highlights the assets and digital competence in the local communities.
- ✓ **Community media skills development** resources addressing audiovisual development, writing, photography, audio and podcasts, visual graphics, and social media.
- ✓ A **Toolkit of Media Moderation Resources** addressing media moderation, the understanding of GDPR and copyright issues.
- ✓ And an **In-service Training for Adult & Community Educators** focused on preparing them with real understanding of fake news and community media.
